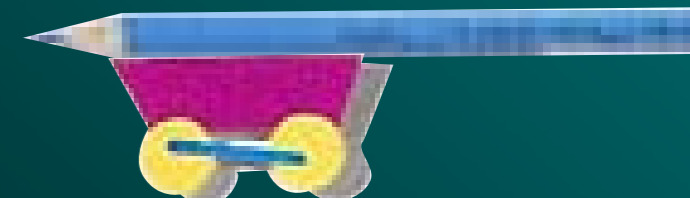


Lakeland Painting

Working with graphite pencils

- 1 An area of solid colour is called tone. Create different tones with your graphite pencils by pressing firmly or gently with the different degrees.
- 2 Use the harder degrees such as 2H for fine, crisp lines and the softer degrees such as 2B to create a soft, smudgy effect.
- 3 To create an impression of depth, draw parallel lines closely together (called hatching). For added texture and form, draw a series of parallel lines, crossing each other at angles (called cross-hatching).

Working with colour pencils

- 4 Apply different colours on top of each other to create many more colours from your original selection.
- 5 Try drawing lots of dots in different colours - some large, some small, some close together, some not so close. See how this creates different effects when viewed from a distance.

Working with painting pencils

- 6 To create soft, rich colours wet the paper first with a paintbrush and water then draw on it with dry pencils.
- 7 For an authentic watercolour effect, draw a picture with dry pencils then wash over it lightly with a wetted paintbrush.
- 8 For strong, dramatic images, try lifting colour directly from the pencil tip using a fine wetted paintbrush, then 'paint' your picture!
